My assistant, Soloman, and I installed the Bird Buffer machine on top of two apple crates, 6' in the air, and pointed the nozzle angled upwards towards the top of the trees over our Gala apple orchard. The timer was placed on a 1-minute on/2-minutes off cycle for 4 hours in the morning and 4 hours in the evening.

Birds were seen leaving the area up to 700' away. The machine was moved to another orchard where the wind blew the haze back towards the house, with about 2+ acres receiving coverage. The power switch was accidentally turned off at the house, when turned back on a large flock of starlings could be seen leaving the orchard where the machine was located.

There was no residue, no grape flavor or bird damage on apples we taste-tested after the Bird Buffer had been in place for a 2 week period. We have seen the unit in action and can testify to its ability to effective bird control in the fields.
