Reduce damage caused by chewing or gnawing animals, rodents and birds with Ropel spray repellent.

Ropel combines the bitterest tasting substance ever discovered with a solvent system to allow it to adhere to different surfaces. Applied full strength, Ropel has no unpleasant odor and is effective against a wide variety of nuisance animals, rodents and birds.

When used as directed, Ropel is effective when applied on siding, fences, posts, unpainted furniture, footings, trees, saplings, plants, bulbs and seeds.

Do not use on edible plants or crops. Ropel can effect the taste.

When animals lick, bite, nibble, peck or chew treated surfaces, they get a bitter reminder that this property is off limits. Ropel has been tested against cattle, deer, dogs, goats, gophers, mice, moles, opossum, rabbits, raccoons, rats, seagulls, skunks, squirrels, woodpeckers, etc, and can remain effective for up to a year when applied correctly.

1 gallon of Ropel can treat 1,000 to 4,000 square feet depending on application and porosity of items being treated.

Application Guidelines

How it works

Ropel is a taste/contact repellent. Animals have to taste it before it will avoid the treated areas. Surface sampling will occur after the initial treatment. Starving animals may continue eating. This can happen when other food sources are unavailable. Ropel is most effective when alternate food sources are available.

Ready to apply

Ropel is ready to use and should be applied full strength. Do not dilute or mix with other chemicals. Wash all equipment before applying.

Application

For best results, treat surfaces until wet. Let air dry, then reapply.

Apply using the trigger sprayers on container or transfer to a conventional garden sprayer. Do not use mist or ULV sprayers. Do not apply on rainy or windy days. Avoid inhaling spray, Ropel is vile tasting. Do not apply indoors.

IF IN DOUBT - TEST IT FIRST!!

Before applying on painted or stained surfaces, plastics, fabrics, wood, etc - test a small area to see if the ingredients in Ropel might change or alter the surface. ALWAYS test the surface first.

On plants

Do not apply on edible plants as it can effect the taste of fruits and vegetables. Do not apply on sugar maple trees if the sap is to be harvested for syrup. Although proven safe for hundreds of plants, it is best to test it on a single plant before wide spread application. Apply to all new plant growth for continued effectiveness.
