## **General Surface Cleaning Instructions**

The steps shown below outline the general procedures to follow when cleaning a surface in preparation of a bird control installation. These steps below outline the **minimum precautions that should be taken**. If heavy accumulations of bird waste is present, additional safety precautions will be required.

> 1. 2. Wear a minimum of protective gloves, Treat the surface and debris with a diseye protection and a respiratory mask infectant. Read and follow the directions to guard against harmful bacteria that on the container. may be present in bird droppings. actericid 3. 4.
